Photography and technology lend artistic expression to the artist's experience of landscapes, cityscapes, and the natural world

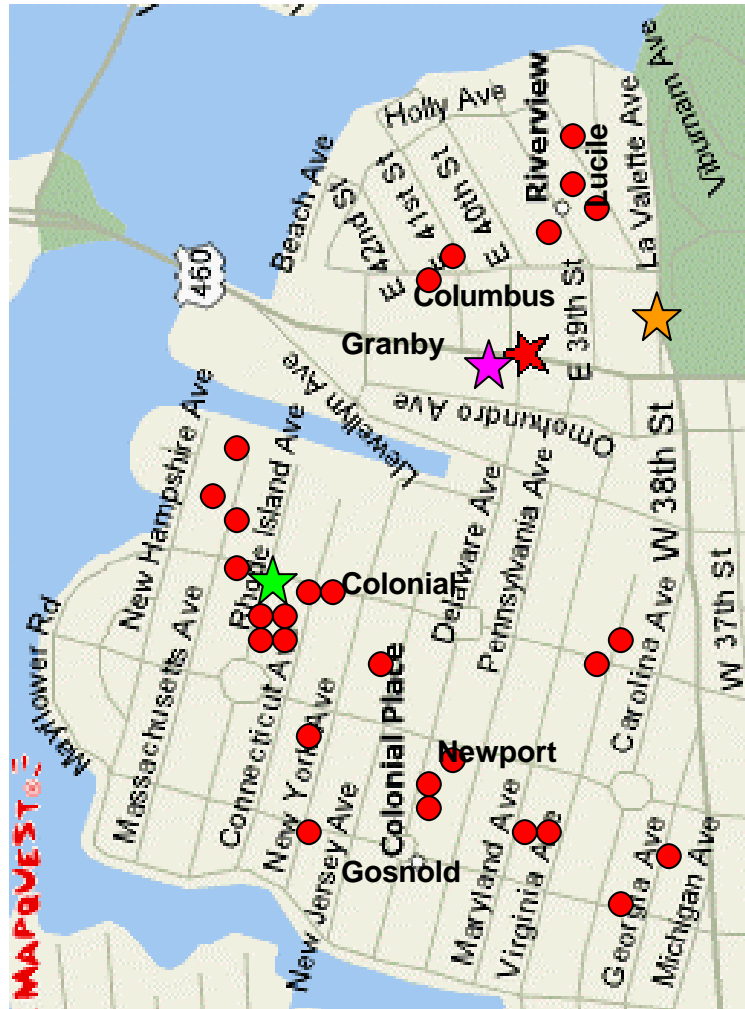

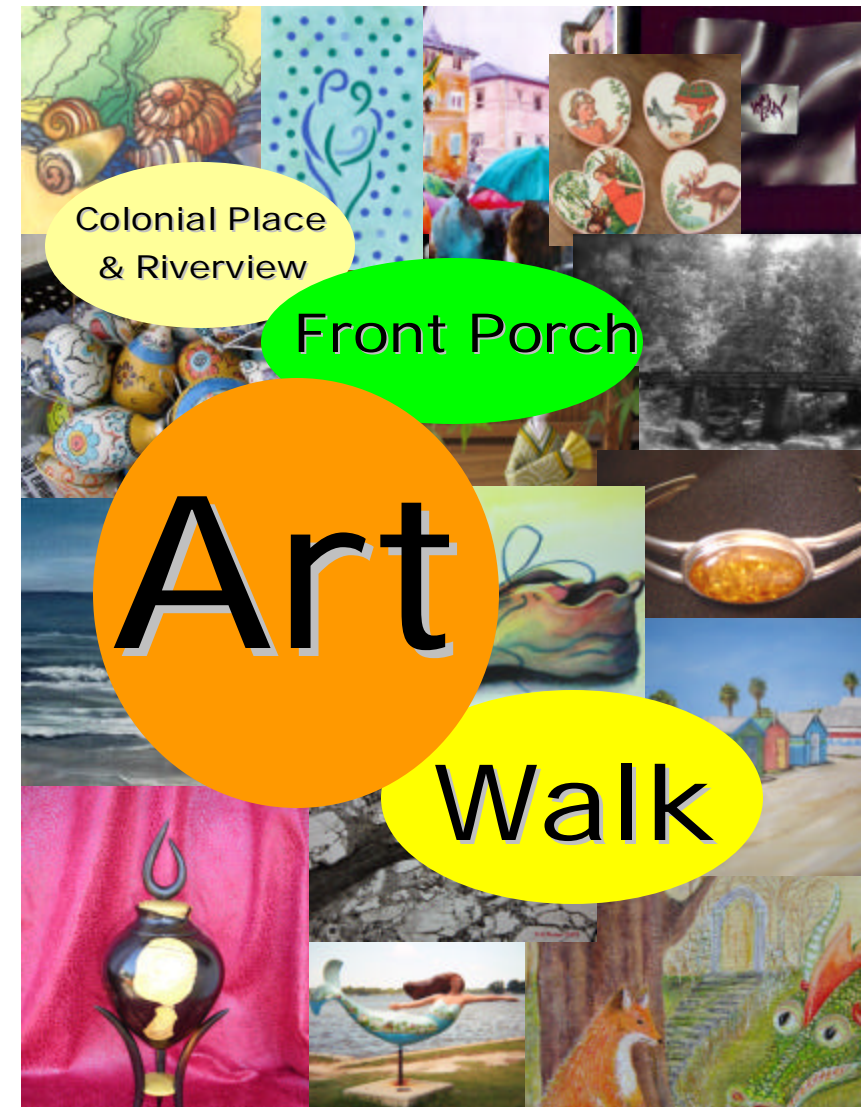
