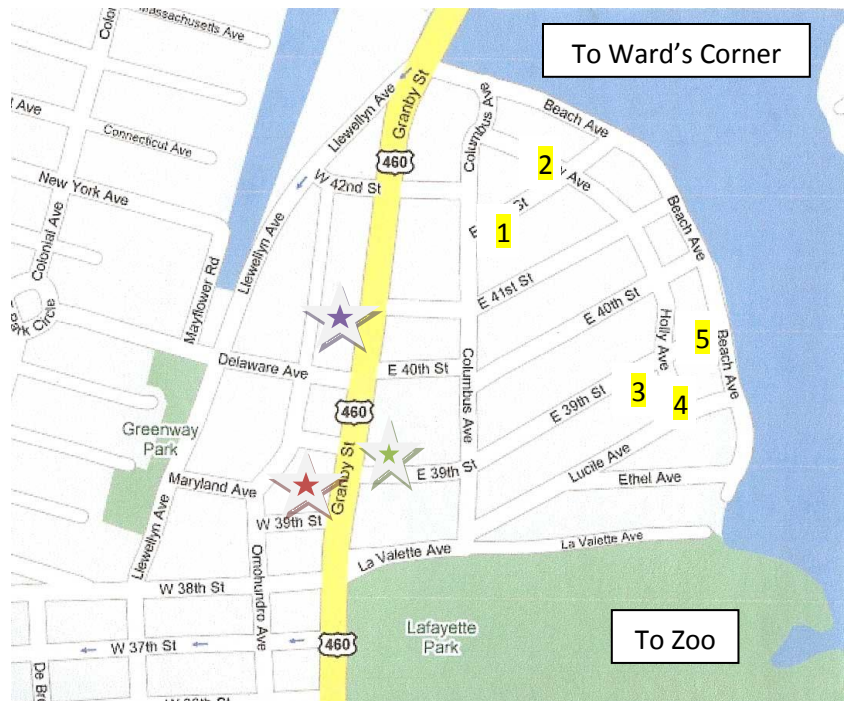
Fiber art

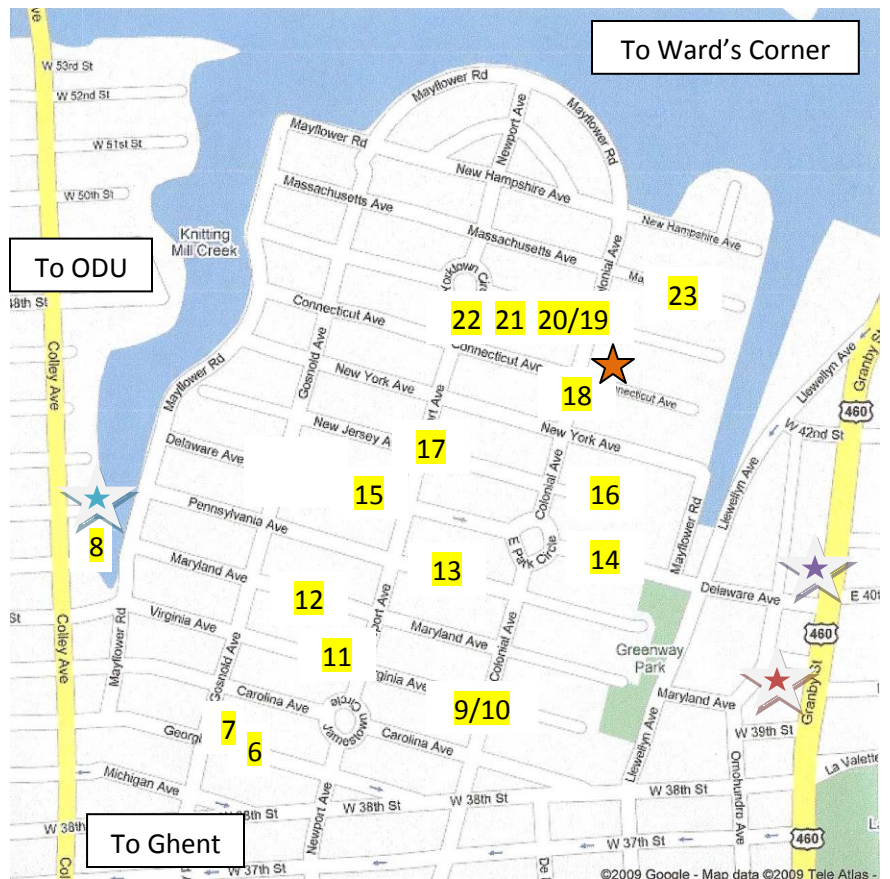
Silver jewelry
